Dave Weigold, N8DPW, Tom Miller, N8TWM, and Duane Meadows, K8MDA reported they went to the .94 repeater site to check out the repeater and discovered the receive portion of the repeater was not

functioning. When they did some work on the .36 repeater and moved some equipment a jumper cable was disconnected. When they were on-site, they discovered this and put the jumper cable back in and the repeater began functioning normally.

The amplifier for the .94 is only putting out 50 amps instead of 75 amps and this is due to one of the switching power supplies possibly having a blown fuse. Duane Meadows, K8MDA has it on his list to look at and try to repair. Each power supply puts out 25 amps.

The portable repeater is measuring 4.5 SWR, it was discovered its an issue with the antenna. Roland Massatti, K8WUA has an antenna he's willing to supply for the portable repeater. It's a dual band antenna. Duane Meadows, K8MDA reported he also has a brand new dual band antenna he isn't using that he would be willing to donate.

APRS with the portable radio was also measuring low output so a replacement radio was used to test and the same performance was noticed. A repair is being made to the TNC, it will be reprogrammed and put back in the trailer in a few days.

ARES

Danny Bailey, W8DLB reported that at the Mohican run there were 181 runners. The Ashland and Wooster clubs assisted. There were two different mile races occurring and it was not apparent which runner was running which mile race. The group also wasn't told who the last runner was and those that coordinated the race took off to Cleveland.
